SUBJECT: HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL 23 AS APPROVED BY CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

Attached is a computer printout (SF9066) which provides the effects of House Substitute for Substitute for Senate Bill 23 as approved by the House/Senate Conference Committee. This bill provides for a \$66 adjustment in base state aid per pupil and two percent in special education. This bill excludes any reductions in capital outlay state aid, capital improvement state aid (bond and interest), supplemental general state aid, and KPERS.

This information has been broken down showing reductions in BSAPP and special education. There are several smaller programs that total approximately \$15 million that will not be reduced under the House version of the bill which include the following: juvenile detention facilities, declining enrollment, mentor teacher, professional development, school food service, educable deaf/blind, agriculture in the classroom, National Board Certification, Kansas Association for Conservation and Environmental Education, and any state sponsored after school programs.
